1.Aim

The 2nd small-scale composting training workshop organized by Swiss Chinese Herbal Medicine and Functional Food Innovation Center (SwissHerbs.Org) and Organic Recycling Research Institute (Suzhou) of China Agricultural University (ORICAU). Our aim is taking full advantage of organic wastes, especially the organic wastes from small farms and gardens. Producing (micro-) biologically high-quality compost is a prerequisite to ensure its long-term value, without harming the environment but to enhance plant vigor and health. Prepared compost is proven to be good organic fertilizer for the cultivation of crops plants.

2.Lecturers

Dr. Jacques G. Fuchs is the Deputy Director of the Academic Board and Senior Researcher of Swiss Chinese Herbal Medicine and Functional Food Innovation Center (SwissHerbs.Org) in Zurich of Switzerland.

He graduated in Agronomy of the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH Zurich) with a PhD in soil microbiology. Since 2019, he has been an Adjunct Professor at the Beijing Key Laboratory of Biodiversity and Organic Agriculture, China Agricultural University and has given technical advice to the




small-scale composting activities of organic waste in Beijing urban and rural farms initiated by the Swiss Federal Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC).

In a career spanning more than 30 years, he has served as a senior expert and consultant on Swiss federal composting technology, providing agricultural practitioners, family farmers, and gardeners with an in-depth introduction to healthy compost production. He is the author of the 《Swiss Federal Guidelines for Compost Quality (Standards) 》 and is the founder of Biophyt in Mellicon. Switzerland (FiBL) has a long history of promoting the world organic agriculture movement, Dr. Fuchs joined FiBL Switzerland in 2000 as a senior expert providing consulting services to a few overseas composting producers. He

has also made outstanding contributions to the development of the use of organic matter compost in soils in many developing countries.

Dr. Liyan Wang joined the Swiss Agency for Development Cooperation (www.deza.ch)



in 2009 and is responsible for the thematic work of SDC in bilateral and multilateral cooperation in China. She plays a central role in the design and management of SDC's pillar projects in China in the areas of emissions reduction and adaptation, including air pollution, water resources management, groundwater over-exploitation management, natural disaster risk assessment, agro-ecology, and solid waste management. Prior to joining SDC, Dr. Liyan Wang worked for state-owned enterprises in the power industry, foreign companies in public utility information

management, and EU energy and environment projects. Dr. Liyan Wang received the PhD in Fluid Power Transmission and Control.

The Swiss Agency for Development Cooperation (SDC) initiated and funded organic waste composting activities on farms and communities in rural and urban area of China. Dr. Liyan Wang successfully led the project and submitted the project report to SDC headquarters in 2021. In this invitation, she will share her hands-on experience in small-scale composting.
